2. Regular Activities: General meetings are normally held on the even months (commencing February) and offer members an opportunity to:
 - Improve their knowledge about clocks, watches and horology
 - Meet and interact with other members, both amateur and professional
 - Obtain first hand advice on repairs and local markets
 - Obtain information on availability of spare parts and materials
 - Socialise with other members

To help achieve this we also conduct workshops meetings on movement repairs and case restoration on the odd months between general meetings. Each workshop features a guest speaker for the day.

3. Regular Speakers: At each meeting there are presentations on various topics relating to clocks and watches.
4. Chapter Library: The Chapter library is the best local reference source of books, videos, DVDs and magazines on clocks, watches and horology in general. These are available for loan at meetings and also by arrangement with our Librarian.
5. Mart: At each General Meeting there is a mart at which clocks, watches and paraphernalia can be bought and sold.
6. There are workshops held each month for you to work on your project and ask questions of other members as you progress.
7. Facilities: The club has some tools and associated facilities which can be used by members during the meetings each month.
8. Annual Auction: the Chapter holds an Annual Auction, usually in April, allowing the Chapter Members to sell/ buy at auction all types of clocks, watches, parts, tools, and books to add to their collections.
9. Newsletter: Our newsletter is published bi-monthly and includes articles of interest to members.
10. Air Conditioned Club Room: Our club room is air conditioned and there is ample parking for members.
11. Chapter Website: Up to date information, library catalogue, useful contacts, and links to useful resources are available 24/7 at www.qldclocksandwatches.org.au/
12. Mentors for beginners: We are welcoming to beginners and there will more than likely be someone who will be happy to help you get your projects started and finished.

General Meetings commence at 12.30 pm and conclude at approximately 4 pm however you are welcome to come as early as 9:00 am to work on your project. Workshop Meetings are also held at Rocklea and commence at about 9:00 am and conclude at about 4.30 pm.
